We were all saddened to hear the news that Ken MacFarlane a seventeen year member of the Toronto Watercolour Society passed away on May 22nd in Newmarket, ON. Ken joined TWS in the year 2000. He was an active member and a vital volunteer taking on the role of Publicity Chair. He received his Signature Membership and his Bronze Level of Distinction -Signature Membership. Ken and his beautiful transparent and serene watercolour paintings won many awards. He won two gold medals in our TWS Shows.

He was an elected member of the Canadian Society of Painters in Watercolour, an honourary member of the Bayview Watercolour Society, and member of the Central Ontario Art Society.

His beautiful transparent washes and sky paintings radiated with serene calmness and light. Ken enjoyed teaching and conducted many successful well-attended workshops at many different locations in Ontario. In each workshop, he shared his knowledge and experience with painters at all levels. Ken loved people and had a down to earth charisma and a true passion for painting transparent watercolour!

His progressive illness and consequent residence in a nursing home kept him away from TWS meetings but he took great delight in receiving his TWS newsletter and keeping up with all the activities. Past President and Director Pauline Holancin visited him recently and said that she had a lovely visit where he was in good spirits asking about a lot of us and about happenings with TWS and COAA. She said they reminisced about many of the fun skits that Ken participated in at the COAA/ECOAA Geneva Park artist weekends, in particular the year Ken (good sport as he was) did a completed painting in 4 minutes (a first for Ken) to the music of William Tell Overture. 
TWS Workshop


It was a fun-filled workshop with florals and a streetscape as subjects.

May, 2018: May 7,8,9,10, 2018

Ron Hazell CSPWC, SCA

In May 2018, we will welcome an East Coast artist Ron Hazell, an elected member of the Canadian Society of Painters in Watercolour(CSPWC) and the Society of Canadian Artists(SCA) for 2 - two day workshops in transparent watercolour. Ron has conducted many workshops across Canada and the United States. Although his subject matter focuses on people and places, light is often the main emphasis in his paintings rather than the subject itself. He is well known for his cityscapes and marine paintings and painting water scenes in many settings.

Our 2 workshops will focus on Water and Light in 2 settings of Canada.





Workshop # 1 will focus on Fresh Water in Ontario (lakes, reflections, waterfalls, rivers rapids docks, sailboats etc etc.) and shorelines.

Workshop #2 will focus Saltwater scenes on the East Coast (fish sheds, wharfs, lobster boats, ocean waves breaking on rock cliffs, and more – all things connected with saltwater.

Both workshops will include the importance of "composition", lighting perspective and the value sketches". Hand-outs will be given out in both workshops.
