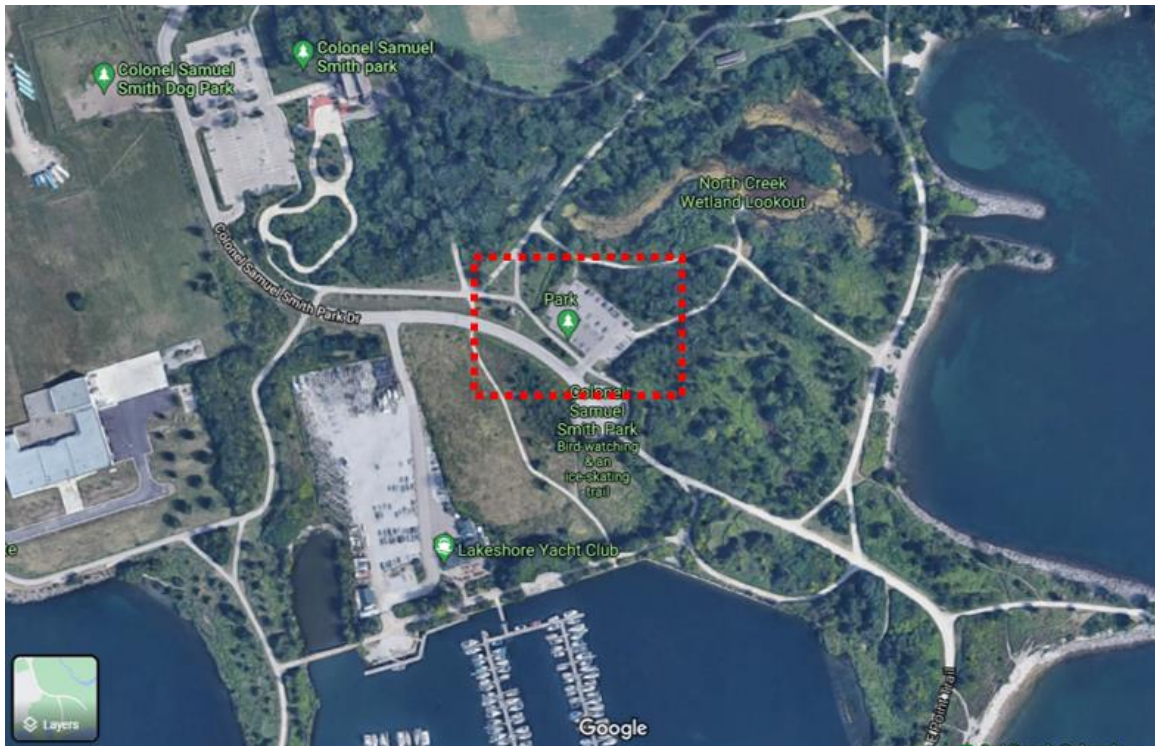
FIRST PRESIDENT'S PAINT OUT at: COLONEL SAMUEL SMITH PARK

SUNDAY JULY 11TH 9:30 am

The first of two President's Paint Outs will take place at the Colonel Samuel Smith Park that is located down along the shore in Etobicoke. As you can see in the aerial view below, there are several parking lots, but I suspect these will fill up fast, so I have set an earlier time of 9:30 am and the session will last until 12:30 pm. At that time we will meet to share the views of our paintings.

I will try to park in the second parking lot (red square), close to the Power House Recreation Centre, to do a quick painting while waiting for others arriving. At 10:15 or so I will head off down to the marina to paint.

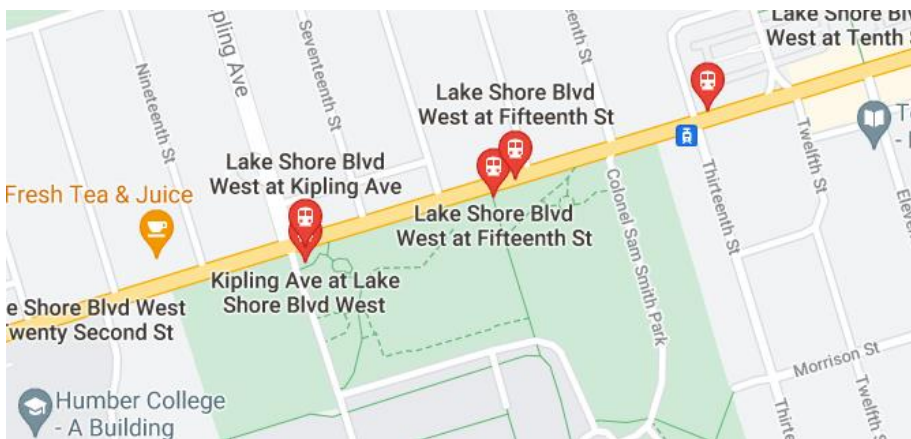

The city website simply states “Portable washrooms near the storage area next to the garage along the chain link fence”, but it was difficult to locate. In the close up view below, there appears to be two portable washrooms (blue circle) beside a small building at the second parking lot. There is also a long open-air gazebo up in the forest area (red circle) where I may also end up for shade or rain protection.



We can meet at 12:30 at the second parking lot near the blue dot washrooms.



There is TTC service to the point of entrance to the park.
